Here are some questions you may have ...and maybe not....but just in case, here you go.

**Q: *Do they really need my help?***

A: Yes, everyone is needed, and everyone will be able to contribute on this day of service.

**Q: *Will this be a COVID safe environment with such a large group of volunteers?***

A: Yes, the organization of the day will allow for social distancing, lunch/refreshments/supplies will be handled safely, and standard mask protocols will be expected from all participants. This day is only successful if everyone goes home safe and healthy. Bring your mask, we'll have the hand sanitizer.

**Q: *What tools should I bring?***

A: Luther Park has limited tools, so I encourage you to bring the tools you want to use. This includes if you plan on

- Construction — personal tools: hammer, tape measure, utility knife, cordless drill, etc
- Yard work— Your favorite rake, brush clipper, and anything that would be helpful

**Q: *Are there any special tools that would be beneficial?***

- Pick-ups and/or trailer to help move pine needles or firewood during the day
- Chainsaw if you are qualified and log splitter if you have one
- DR Blade Mower if you have access to one

**Q: *Is the effort worth it?***

A: Luther Park has a vision, and that vision is to maintain and advance the camp to be available for many years to come. This one day of service will be a huge boost to the camp's needs. Not to mention the fact that there are many excited youth already signed up to go to camp this summer.
