FAITH CENTERED

Faith teachings and practices are not peripheral or intermittent aspects of the camp experience, but rather are experienced as intertwined in all other characteristics.



AFE SPACE

The strong sense of safety at camp includes physical, but also an emphasis on emotional safety. Participants described camp as a place where they could be themselves without fear of judgment.



PARTICIPATORY

The camp environment emphasizes experience and agency. Participants learn and grow through active, kinesthetic activities that employ their body, mind, and soul



UNPLUGGED FROM HOME

Camp exists in a set apart location that provides physical and emotional distance from environments that participants consider normal, allowing them to see the world and their place in it differently.



RELATIONAL

Camp experience is framed in a relational environment that includes living together, meeting new people, practicing reconciliation, and encountering the other in face-to-face interaction.

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

The Ministry Center has seen steady usage this summer and fall, with camper worships, synod meetings, quilt and crafters groups and a wedding. Luther Park has had excellent reviews by all groups who love the building and the future ministry. Luther Park is also seeing increased interest in the Ministry Center as well as the camp ministry in general. Fall of 2021 is looking to be very busy!



To date we have raised in gifts and pledges over

\$2,100,000! To date Luther Park has raised \$425,600.00

toward the Dave and Carolyn Cleveland \$500,000 matching funds. We just need to raise from our churches \$74,400 to complete this match by December 30, 2021! This has been an amazing gift to the camp!

The Menomonie match is also nearing completion and we expect to have that complete by the end of the year. This \$100,000 matching fund gift, was a catalyst for so much more.

Work continues to progress on the lower level thanks to staff and volunteers. This work is being completed as time and finances allow.

The total cost of the campaign is expected to be about \$175,000 over the original goal. With this in mind, we continue to encourage individual donors to partner with us in this **project of Growth and Ministry**.

Donor churches and individuals are being recognized on the donor board in the lobby of the Ministry Center. This beautiful board was made and donated by one of the camp's wonderful board members and has space for more names and the ability to shift names into different categories.
