Here are some questions you may have ...and maybe not....but just in case, here you go.

Q: Do they really need my help?

A: Yes, everyone will be able to contribute in this day of service. The more people we have, the more we will be able to accomplish. The camp only has one part time maintenance person. They really need volunteers to complete the work that is above and beyond the day to day.

Q: What tools should I bring?

A: Luther Park has limited tools, so I encourage you to bring the tools you want to use. This includes if you plan on

- Construction — personal tools: hammer, tape measure, utility knife, cordless drill, etc,
- Deep cleaning— rubber gloves, general cleaning tools and supplies
- Yard work— Your favorite rake, shovel, and anything that would be helpful

Q: Are there any special tools that would be beneficial?

- Pick-up or trailer to help move pine needles or firewood during the day
- There are two power washers, but one or two more would be put to good use
