

FAMILY CAMP Facts Sheet

Enclosed you will find:

Registration Acknowledgement: Check the information to make sure it is accurate.

Camp Packing List: Use this to help you pack!

Canteen List: We have a camp store. Use this list to help you determine how much spending money to bring.

Camper Health, Emergency and Authorized Information Form: If you bring a child that you are not the legal guardian/parent of, you need to have a completed health history form for that child. Otherwise, no health form needs to be filled out for families.

What will I be doing at Luther Park?

IDEA!

Label everything you bring with your name so if it gets misplaced people know who it belongs to.

ARRIVAL:

What time do we arrive? Sunday between 3-4pm

Where do we check in? Check-in is in the Chapel.

What will happen when I get there? There will be counselors to greet you in the Welcome Center parking lot. You will then need to check-in. At check-in you will be assigned a place to stay and a counselor.

Do I need to check in at registration even if I have already paid? Yes, that is how we know who is here and who isn't.

Can I park my car in front of my cabin? The road in between cabins is an EMERGENCY fire route and cannot be blocked by camper vehicles for safety reasons. We ask families to park and unload belongings from the Welcome Center parking lot with the help of our "strong" counselors!

HEALTH AND SAFETY ANSWERS:

What do I do with the Camper Health Form

you sent me? If you are bringing a child that you are NOT the legal guardian/parent of, then you need to have the legal guardian/parent of that child fill out the form and sign it. Luther Park cannot allow any child to stay at camp without his or her legal guardian/parent unless a current health history form is filled out and signed by his/her legal guardian/parent.

Does the child need a physical by a physician?

We recommend one every two years but it is not required.

When does Luther Park need the Health Form?

Either mail it in two weeks before your start date or bring the signed form with you to camp at check-in time.

Will we be safe?

The staff is highly trained. There are Emergency Responders available 24 hours a day no matter where you or your child are. There are trained lifeguards at the pool and trained counselors at the recreation areas.

What about insurance? Each camper is covered primarily by their own insurance and secondarily by Luther Park's Accident Insurance Policy.

DEPARTURE TIME:

What time do we leave? Departure time is 12:00 pm on Friday. You can invite friends to the closing worship at 11:00am if you would like.

What if I leave something at Luther Park?

Please check for Lost and Found items on display at the Dining Hall during departure times. We only keep items for two weeks and then they are given to a local charity.

MISC QUESTIONS:

Can we bring a bicycle? Yes. Many people bring non-motorized bicycles (motorized are not allowed). Be sure to bring safety helmets, knee and elbow pads as well.

Will I be able to have a nap? Yes, the counselor that is assigned to you can play with your children when you want to rest.

What if I have a food allergy? Let us know in advance and we will accommodate you to the best of our ability.

Where will we be staying and can I bring bedding instead of a sleeping bag? The Shalom Center has individual rooms and shared bathrooms. Duplex cabins have a bathroom and shower in the cabin. Yes you may bring bedding instead of sleeping bags. All facilities have twin beds. If you are staying in Platform tents, we recommend bringing a sleeping pad. If using the RV sites, the electric hookup is 110 volt; bathrooms in the Welcome Center.

Do I need to bring towels, washcloths and soap? Yes.

Will my family be together for Bible study? We have Bible study groups for certain ages. The adults will be together and children will be divided into smaller age-appropriate groups.

MONEY ANSWERS:

If I cancel, will I get my deposit refunded?

The required deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable after May 1. If cancellation occurs prior to May 1, the deposit will be refunded less a \$25 processing fee.

When is the rest of my payment due?

If possible, please mail the final payment at least two weeks in advance, or you may pay it when you arrive on Sunday.

What if my Family or I can't afford to come to Luther Park? If you need a campership or know someone who does, please download a form at LutherPark.org or call us. We make every effort to ensure that no one is turned away from Luther Park because of inability to pay. We are very grateful to all the people who make it possible for kids and families to come to camp through their generous financial gifts.

When is the canteen open? At check-in and departure times. Also, once in the afternoon and once in the evening while you are here.

Canteen Procedure You will be able to purchase canteen cards when you arrive. Canteen cards eliminate the need to carry cash while you are at camp. Any money left on your canteen cards will be reimbursed on Friday when you leave. You will be able to purchase additional canteen cards during your stay.

Do I pay for crafts? All craft materials are included, except if you want to purchase an item to tie dye (or bring your own).

May I use a credit card? Yes, we accept Discover, MasterCard and Visa.

OTHER MISC QUESTIONS:

May I bring my guitar? Yes, feel free to bring a musical instrument and share your talents with us!


What if I can't sing? God said make a joyful noise, not a pretty noise. No one will notice. Really!
