


2020 ANNUAL REPORT 87 Years of Ministry!

Dear Partners in Ministry

2020 was an unusual year to say the least. Luther Park started the year with a lot of excitement and anticipation for a new year of ministry and the addition of the much anticipated new Ministry Center.

However, change and unpredictability is constant. During the spring with the onset of Covid 19 and so many unanswered questions the board had to make the very difficult decision to suspend the summer camp program at Luther Park. The decision was not made lightly or without a great deal of conversation and prayer. So, for the first time in 87 years there were to be no youth at camp.

Years ago I used to be an avid rock climber. Some climbs were only 50 or 60 feet, others were hundreds of feet. During many of the more difficult climbs it was not uncommon to fall. But it was during these more difficult climbs where more time was spent in preparation, time setting up systems and people in the right place to catch a potential fall. So when the fall happened after the initial intake of breath you relaxed a bit and let the system take over.

That is a bit of what 2020 was for us. Luther Park is built on a firm foundation of support and partnership. We lost most of our earned income in rentals and programs. We had to restructure some areas and then focus on what we could do.

However, Luther Park continued in ministry virtually with limited staff. We continued in stewardship by taking the time given to us to work on needed building improvements, and future planning for programs and development. Luther Park had to and still does rely on our safety lines to our churches, volunteers and donors. Luther Park ended the year in the red financially but will remain strong and is extremely excited about the ministry ahead for 2021 and long into the future.

Luther Park joins so many other in prayer for those for whom Covid 19 affected, the many families who lost loved ones, finances or were sick. You are still in our prayers. We also pray for all the children whose summers of fun, fellowship and growth were restricted.

We can not begin to thank enough all the people who help make this ministry happen in so many ways, these are: staff, the volunteers, those that donate to the auction and other events, those that donate to the annual funds and give gifts "in-kind", through Thrivent choice, amazon smile and memorial gifts. There are so many generous givers and we humbly thank one and all.

This is truly a place of grace and ministry.



Luther Park normally hires about 35 summer staff each year. Most are college age.


Each year Luther Park visits many of our Lutheran and various state colleges to recruit these amazing young adults.

While Summer programs are the cornerstone of the ministry of Luther Park, there is much more ministry happening. Below is some of what your camp ministry does.

Youth "Recharge" Retreats

Typically there are 3-4 of these events each year that are designed for youth to "recharge" their faith. These 24 hour events are full of worship, fun service and fellowship.





Quilt Retreats

Luther Park hosts four events open to all abilities.

Five other groups rent facilities for which Luther Park provides the set up and ministry of hospitality





Adult Retreats

Some are through our partnership with our churches and the Synod office, others are in appreciation or for education.

Guest Groups

Include church retreats, family reunions, weddings, college or school groups, education events, organizations like AA or Cerebral Palsy camps.

Guest groups renting one of the Luther Park facilities extends the ministry of Luther Park while providing some much needed extra income.



It Happened in 2020

- ☐ Painting of the exterior of 8 cabins, the Welcome Center, Dining Center, Pool house, Bathhouse, Craft Cabin, most of Shalom Center as well as the machine shed at the Farm Center. Over 90 gallons of paint was used this summer.
- ☐ The addition of 2 hammock village areas for campers to use for relaxing times, Bible studies and small group discussions.
- ☐ Our summer staff was able to send out weekly electronic worships and encouragements to our camp family.
- □ The logging was finished to remove the hundreds of downed, leaning, or dangerous trees after the July 2019 storm.
- ☐ The new Ministry Center was completed and ready for use. (Unfortunately, many groups previously booked had to cancel due to Covid-19.)
- ☐ Trail signs were completed and ready to be installed in the spring.
- ☐ Three cabins had bathrooms remodeled.
- ☐ A small deck and stairs were added to the back of the Craft Cabin to improve safety and appearance.
- ☐ Insulation was added to Shalom to improve energy efficiency and stewardship.
- ☐ The Golf Fundraising event happened with great results despite inclement weather.
- □ Our very first combination on-line and in-person Quilt Auction happened which raised over \$28,000. And while this is a bit less than our recent events it was still a rousing success!
- □ Processes were established for programming in 2021 taking into consideration Covid-19 will still be a problem. Policies and procedures will hopefully mitigate any potential danger.





Notes on Financial Statement:

- Special Undesignated line of \$64,657 was a PPP grant.
- General supplies and repairs line includes food, building repairs and improvements, office supplies, garbage and fire.
- Interest expense is the interest on the loan for the building of which \$25,000 has been paid by a donor and corresponding amount is in income in the Annual Funds.
- \$9,000 of the Annual Funds Income is a diversity grant from Lutheran Outdoor Ministry.



Audit Report

Luther Park did not conduct the normally scheduled financial review of 2019 scheduled for 2020. The board voted to temporarily suspend the review pending a vote by the constituency.

In awareness of the extremely tight financial situation of 2020 and on recommendation of the accounting firm, it was decided that since Luther Park Bible Camp, Inc has had many years of clean and clear audit reports, it would be the best stewardship of limited resources to forego the 2019 financial review.

If the constituency deems necessary at the Annual meeting the Review can be conducted in 2021. The approximate cost of a review is \$4,000-\$4,500.

Thrivent Action Grants

During 2020 Luther Park Bible Camp was the recipient of 30 different Action Grants from our supporting Thrivent members. These grants of \$250 each helped fund many of the projects that were accomplished this summer.

Projects included exterior paint for all buildings on site, hammocks for the Hammock village, supplies for bathroom remodels, addition of energy efficiency at Shalom, a deck at Creators Corner, craft supplies for youth retreats, advertising for the Golf Event, Heart For Luther Park Auction supplies and more.

Any Thrivent member can apply for 2 per calendar year. It is quick and easy and if you are interested Luther Park has many ideas for 2021.



Capital Campaign Annual Report 2020

Campaign Background in Brief

In 2016 discussions and surveys began on the possibility of having a Capital Campaign to build an new multipurpose Ministry Center. It was felt that based on the current rate of growth and the need to accommodate large groups year-round a new multipurpose building was needed. The desire was to have meeting space that would hold almost 300 with plenty of bathrooms and a breakout space.

In 2017 preliminary drawing were developed, interviews with alumni and donors began and initial large donation pledges were sought.

In **2018** the initial \$600,000 in pledges were received and the final site plan and drawings completed.

In 2019 with the offer of the Menomonie Church match of \$100,000 to extend through 2021. The offer of Cleveland church match of \$500,000 to be in 2020 - 2021 and the offer of a no interest construction loan to get started the Building and Rejoicing Capital Campaign officially started. In May of that year was the kick-off celebration and in November construction of the new Ministry Center began. Additional individual donations and pledges were added.

In **2020** the Ministry Center was completed (except for the lower level which will be completed by volunteers as funds are available). About 1.9 million of the 2.2 million dollar goal was collected in gifts or pledges.

In **2021** the goal is to complete the matching funds and continue with individual donations to work toward the completion of the lower level.



Thanks to the **Dave and Carolyn Cleveland matching funds** and that of the Menomonie donor, church donations and support grew as well as support from other individual donors with large and small gifts. These amazing and timely gifts assured the success of this project of Ministry and Growth.


