- Rooms & cabins are a combo of twin beds and lower bunk beds (linens NOT provided). All have shared bathrooms.
- 1 (only 3 available) and 2 per room have an additional charge of \$25/person for rooms in the Welcome Center and Shalom - also shared bathrooms (photos on our website at www.lutherpark.org)
- **Rooms are reserved on a first come basis**
- RV space with electrical only, no cost
