Auction Item Donation Guidelines

There are so many ways to donate to Heart for Luther Park!

Please consider one of the following:

Quilts

- Bidders enjoy a variety of handmade, machine quilted or hand quilted pieces. It is nice to have quilts of all sizes; however, queen size quilts seem to be the most sought after.
- Many of our bidders are quilt-lovers but not necessarily quilt-makers. They are looking for "quilts with a story." We encourage you to share your inspiration for your quilt, details about its design and who made it, etc. Any information you share will be appreciated and certainly cherished along with the quilt. Please include this information on your donation's completed form.

Silent Auction Items

- Bidders enjoy having a wide variety of items in the Silent Auction. Items that are most popular: gift or themed baskets, event tickets, vacation rental opportunities, fine crafted items (such as embroidered dish towels or wood carvings), baked goods, and more.
- Consider donating a quilt for the silent auction! Smaller quilts or other handmade items are a delightful addition to the silent auction. Each item will include a minimum bid to honor the value of each donated item.
- Please note that we will need to display silent auction items. If you are offering an experience, please consider sharing any photos you have that can help show it off!

Common Thread Market – New this year!

- **What is the Common Thread Market?** – The Common Thread Market is a maker's market where you can find supplies for your next creative project. Market items will be available for a free-will donation benefiting Luther Park. With no set prices, guests can give what they feel led to give while finding inspiration for their next project.
- **Donate items to the Common Thread Market!** We welcome donations of materials used in hobbies focused on making and building including (but not limited to) quilting, needlework, knitting, general crafting, specialty or heritage baking/cooking, soap making, woodworking, candle making, weaving, scrapbooking, painting, drawing, pottery, jewelry making, etc.
- Donated items must be **new or very, very gently used**. For example, a new or barely used bottle of glue is welcome; a half-empty bottle is not. Any items not claimed during the market will be donated to a local thrift store.

Please note:

We are so grateful for every donation and take great care in how each item is used. By donating an item to Luther Park, you are giving us permission to determine the perfect fit for the event, depending on the total number of items donated and the makeup of donations. Your piece may be put in the Live/Online Auction, Silent Auction, or Common Thread Market.

Delivering Your Donation Items

- **Please complete the donation information form enclosed and attach to each donated item as best you can.** It is very important that the information is shared to keep accurate records and to give proper credit to those donating items.
- Donations of quilts and other items will be accepted **until Monday, July 20**. This allows adequate time to process your items. Any items received after July 20 may not be included in all publications, or could possibly be saved for the 2027 event.
- If you are donating an item that needs to be delivered after July 20 (for example: baked goods that need to be fresh), please notify Heather Day.
- Donations can be dropped off at Luther Park Bible Camp or mailed to Luther Park at 944 24 ¼ Street, Chetek, WI 54728. The best time to donate items is during office hours, Monday to Friday from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM. If you need to deliver items at a different time, please contact Heather to make other arrangements.
